Why we do it





Financial Highlights...



Donated Flight Instruction - AEFEO has support of Certified Flight Instructors (CFI) who provide flight instruction and waive the fees that would normally be charged. Those hours which include flight instruction and consultation before and after are valued at \$55.00 per hour. During the year ended December 31, 2012, CFI's donated \$3833.50 as detailed below:


Donated Other Services - Substantial services are provided by non-compensated private pilots performing demonstration flights with students during the Aviation Summer Academy. Pilots are donating their time, airplane, and all associated expenses. AEFCO is conservatively applying a value of \$60.00 per flight derived from direct expenses. Direct expenses include fuel and oil directly consumed by the aircraft in the demonstration flight and transportation to get to and from the airport.






